Responsibilities: Provides instruction, advisement, and mentoring; engages in scholarship and/or professional creative work as well as offering university and community service; teaching duties include general music classes and applied music, as well as specific courses in music theory, voice, piano, instrumental music, musicianship, and music education; provides outside classroom work to include advising majors, performance rehearsals, keeping office hours, and serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees; maintains active participation in creative and/or university committees. This position is tenure track.

Qualifications: D.M.A., Ph.D., or Ed.D. in Music required. Minimum of five (5) years of teaching music on the university level and a minimum of five (5) years recent experience teaching music on the elementary and/or secondary school levels. At least five (5) years of consistent professional experience in music is also required. Demonstrated successful experience in music curriculum development and working knowledge of teaching with technology and classroom management tools, such as BlackBoard; experience with teaching diverse student populations is an asset. Candidate should be open to working beyond scheduled classroom and office hours when necessary.
