Qualifications: Ph.D. in Chemistry with specialization in Analytical Chemistry preferred. Postdoctoral experience in Analytical Chemistry preferred. Minimally, a Masters in Analytical Chemistry is required, if the Ph.D. is in another chemistry discipline. Excellent communication skills and a strong commitment to excellence in teaching, technology application in the classroom, and the ability to develop a research program that includes undergraduate students. Successful experience in obtaining funded grants is preferred. Strong candidates will be a team player, possess leadership potential, and have experience working with underrepresented minorities in STEM.
