Contributes to the program, department, university, and surrounding community; advises students; assists with field practica; collaborates with colleagues; strong commitment to understanding diversity in the field; teaches evenings and works some weekends.

Qualifications: Ph.D., Ed.D., or Psy.D. in Counseling Psychology and/or Community Mental Health Counseling, or a related area required. Minimum four (4) years part or full time experience at an institution of higher education required.
