### **KEY INITIATIVES AND RESEARCH ACTIVITIES**

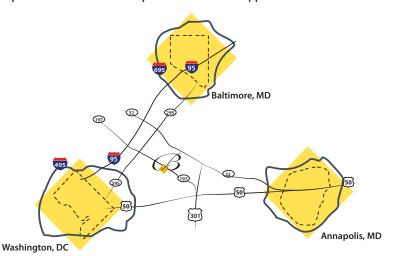
Education Innovation Initiative (ei2), Bowie State's first signature program, provides real-world work experience for students to develop technology-based solutions to real-world problems of local corporations. Through a partnership with technology giant Lockheed Martin, students have access to the latest cloud computing technologies and industry mentors who are leaders in the field. Lockheed Martin has invested more than \$2 million to outfit the Bowie State campus with state-of-the-art technical equipment and software to support ei2.

The Virtual Reality Laboratory in the Bowie State Computer Science Department incorporates the latest 3D technology that allows students to work in 3D space to solve complex problems like evaluating human behavior in emergency situations. The research performed here supports ongoing refinement of emergency evacuation procedures and other areas of national security preparedness.

Expanding research programs in the biosciences at Bowie State provide opportunities for students to work at the forefront of innovation, creating biomedicines, extracting and synthesizing DNA, producing genetically modified materials and much more. Students majoring in bioinformatics learn to incorporate the application of technology to explore biological questions.

### LOCATION

The Baltimore-Washington-Annapolis triangle serves as a center of international, national, and regional business, government and technology. Located within close proximity to each of these urban hubs, the University has on-campus access to the MARC train and Metrobus, making it easy for students and faculty to connect with opportunities across the metro region.
