We have received a copy of your FAFSA application, based on the information received you indicated that as of today either you/your spouse (*if Independent*) or one of your parent(s) is a dislocated worker. If a person quits work, generally he or she is not considered a dislocated worker.

In addition to this form, you must provide the V1 Verification Worksheet, all W-2's, and Federal Tax Transcripts.

In order for you/your spouse or your parent(s) to be considered a dislocated worker one of the following criteria must be met:

- Loss of job
- Laid off or received a lay-off notice from their job
- Receiving unemployment benefits due to being laid off or losing a job and are unlikely to return to a previous occupation
- Self-employed but are unemployed due to economic conditions or natural disaster.

If, you/your spouse or your parent(s) fall into either one of the categories listed above the following documentation will be required in addition to Verification documents.
