## The Elizabeth Thomas Opportunity Scholarship Award Scholarship Criteria

**The Elizabeth Thomas Opportunity Scholarship Award** was established in September 2009 to award a \$5,000 annual scholarship for tuition and mandatory fees to an eligible undergraduate student with a declared major in Social Work.

1. Eligible applicants must have completed at a minimum of six credit hours in Social Work which includes SOWK 200 and SOWK 300.
2. All applicants must be accepted into the Social Work program, display a promising future in Social Work and meet the minimum 2.5 G.P.A.
3. All applicants must submit a one page or less response to the questions listed below.
  - a. Indicate why you need this scholarship award.
  - b. Indicate why you should be selected to receive the scholarship award.
