It is not a defense that the person (or group) against whom the hazing was directed consented to, or acquiesced to, the behavior in question.
Outcome(s)	Conduct Probation: May 19, 2025 - May 21, 2027 University Restriction: No social events through December 19, 2025 Educational Requirement: Conduct one hazing prevention program in Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 Community Service: 160 hours (half on campus; half off campus)

Additionally, Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. was found responsible for subjecting prospective/new members to verbal abuse including, but not limited to, screamig at them.
