This report form is an opportunity for any individual to provide information concerning an alleged violation of Bowie State University's Code of Student Conduct. You may submit a report by completing the online form below. This form is specifically for reporting alleged policy violations against BSU students. Once submitted, this form will be reviewed by the Office of Student Conduct & Community Standards. Depending on the information provided, one of the following actions may be taken:

- -No Action: Incidents that fall outside of university jurisdiction, do not involved a current student, or have a lack of information provided. If the reporting party is unable to provide specific, identifiable information about the individual(s) who have allegedly violated the Code of Student Conduct, it is likely that no action will be taken.
- **-Further Investigation:** Initial reports filed may require further follow up by university officials. The more detailed the information provided via this form, the more timely the process of review may begin. If further investigation is necessary, the individual submitting this report may be contacted by a university official to provide more information.
- -Student(s) notified of alleged policy violation(s): Reports filed may lead to a student receiving an official notice of alleged policy violations. Respondent students may be contacted and a student conduct conference may be held to resolve the matter.
- *Note regarding Confidentiality: Information collected via this reporting form will be treated as confidential and is protected under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA). The report is an educational record. The Office of Student Conduct & Community Standards staff, the student who is alleged to have violated the Code of the Student Conduct, and those with an educational need to know may view the report.






You have the option to capture any location on campus or off campus


