The new @400 space parking lot is complete. The new lot (Lot I) will include an extensive solar panel canopy network- similar to that of Lot G. The solar installation is expected to be completed by the end of February.


<u>Bikeshare program</u>--- THE BIKESHARE PROGRAM IS A HIT! The Student Center operates the program from the Gameroom. Check the website for more details.



<u>Solar charging units</u>--- The outdoor charging units for charging smart devices while you sit at a bench are installed. These are off-grid, 100% solar powered units strategically placed in three locations across campus: two on the East promenade in front of the Student Center lawn, facing the rear of the Library, and one placed next to the bench between TM Library and Henry Bldg nearest to Henry Circle.



Mini solar table by Kennard—SolGreen Solutions replaced all four of the seats of the table over the winter break. The new seats are guaranteed to be much sturdier, durable and longer lasting.





Big Belly trash compactor— Verizon, T-Mobile and AT&T announced plans to discontinue their 3G networks beginning Dec 31, 2019 and all stations would have to be converted to the 4G LTE network which should last through the year 2030. As a result, BigBelly performed the necessary upgrades to both of our on -campus Bigbelly stations to make them up to date and now fully compatible.
