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## HYPOTHESES

1. Our hypothesis is that the more the person attended church the less likely they will be pro abortion.

## - Resulits

-The higher the score for church attendance the lower the score for abortion.

- 54 Students
-49 Women/5 Men
-Average age = 22
- Race

African American( $\mathrm{N}=51$ )


Latino(a) ( $\mathrm{N}=1$ )
Asian ( $\mathrm{N}=1$ )
Middle Eastern ( $\mathrm{N}=1$ )

## MFASURES



- Spirituality ( yes=2, somewhat=1,no=0)
- Church attendance(Frequently=3, occasionally=2, holidays only=1, never-0)
- Pro abortion( Strongly agree=3, agree=2, disagree $=1$, strongly disagree $=0$ )


## DISCUSSION

The results from this study suggest the following:

- The more spiritual and the more the person attend church the least likely they were to be in favor of abortion.
- Limitations we experienced was the pandemic, limited amount of questions we could ask on the survey and how we collected the data
- Strengths were that we were assisted with creating survey, received timely responses and data was complied for us.
