
Does Marijuana Use Affect College Students GPA?

PARTICIPANTS


- **4** 49 surveys in total
- ❖ Gender: 41 women, 5 men, 3 no responses
- Race: 40 African Americans, 3 Latinos, 1
 Caucasian, 1 Asian, 1 Other

MEASURES

- Do you use marijuana?
- How many times daily, do you use marijuana?
- How many times monthly do you marijuana?
- How many times each month do your college friends use marijuana?
- These four questions help us to analyze the use of marijuana by college students and if it affects their GPA.

RESULTS

The use of marijuana did not have an effect on college student's GPAs r(44) = .-19, p = 0.209Results are not significant



DISCUSSION

- The results of this study suggest the following
- There was no correlation between marijuana use and college student's GPA's.
- Future study is necessary explore the use marijuana and college student outcomes.
