#### 2017 – 2018 Verification Worksheet

Your 2017–2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we (Department of Education) may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, financial aid administrators at Bowie State University will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. Warning: if you purposely give false or misleading information on this worksheet, you may be fined, be sentenced to jail, or both.
