**POSITION TITLE:** Assistant Professor of Art

**Responsibilities:** The primary duties for this tenure-track position are teaching undergraduate art foundation courses for general education and majors, as well as intermediate and upper division courses in at least one of the following areas: 2D (drawing, painting, printmaking); 3D (sculpture, ceramics); Photography, or Mixed Media / Integrated Studios; may also teach art history courses. Expectations include teaching, office hours / advising, committee service, participation in course and program development, and creative production and/or research activities.

**Qualifications:** An MFA in a studio art discipline or an equivalent degree in a related field is required. Minimum three (3) years of teaching experience on the university level preferred. Evidence of strong independent studio practice and exhibition record, demonstrated knowledge of pedagogy and teaching methodologies appropriate to undergraduate level students majoring in art disciplines and students using the course as a general education requirement; knowledge of global art history and practice from prehistoric through present day as well as current trends and studio technology; knowledge of appropriate classroom technology, to include the Learning Management System Blackboard. The ideal candidate will contribute to the diversity of the program by bringing a perspective, way of thinking, and/or a unique set of experiences that expand the intellectual and creative conversation and artistic practices in the field.

**APPLICATIONS:** Interested and qualified applicants should submit two copies of a resume/curriculum vitae, cover letter/letter of interest and teaching philosophy (to include perspective and experience related to current trends such as sustainable / green studio practices, design thinking, artistic research methodology, creative problem solving and innovation, etc.), official transcript(s), along with a faculty application, at least three (3) letters of reference, 10 - 20 Samples of Artwork / Research, and 10 – 20 Samples of Student Work. **Submissions without an application will not be considered.** Email or mail all documents to:
