Responsibilities: The primary duties for this tenure-track position are teaching theatrical design and other courses in theatre studies; designing two main stage and two black box productions each academic year; mentoring student designers, advising and mentoring undergraduate students, consistently maintaining active participation in creative and/or scholarly endeavors, and offering university and community service. Responsibilities also include outside classroom work, such as supporting performance rehearsals and ongoing professional development.

Qualifications: MFA or PhD in Scenography or other design areas with primary strength in scene design (including scenic painting) and secondary strength in lighting design or costume design. Minimum three (3) years of teaching experience in higher education that is beyond graduate studies. Evidence of strong interpersonal and organizational skills; an ability to collaborate with fine and performing arts faculty; evidence of artistic achievement in professional theatrical design; evidence of excellence in teaching in higher education; evidence of continuing creative and/or scholarly work; working knowledge of emerging design technologies and software, digital media, and/or projection design; ability to build interdisciplinary and community partnerships; ability to develop and assess curriculum and co-curricular experiences for undergraduate students.

Condition of Employment: Open and available to working beyond scheduled classroom and office hours when necessary.
