**Responsibilities:** Teaches across multiple areas, with a focus on mental health counseling. Teaches graduate courses such as Foundations in Mental Health Counseling, Prevention and Intervention in Counseling, Research Methods and Statistics, Program Evaluation, Drug and Alcohol Counseling, and Advanced Techniques in Counseling. Curriculum instruction and program development; student advisement; assisting with field practica; collaboration with colleagues; active scholarship and grantsmanship/fund-raising; contributing to the program, department, university, and surrounding community. This is a full-time tenure track faculty position.

**Qualifications:** Ph.D. or an Ed.D., in Counseling in the areas of School Counseling and/or Community Mental Health Counseling, and/or Counselor Education and Supervision, or a related area from a program approved by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP). Experience teaching courses in the specialty area and an active program of teaching research in school, educational and/or mental health counseling is highly desirable along with a strong interest in teaching related courses; demonstrated commitment to graduate education and proven record of potential effectiveness in teaching, scholarly research, and community outreach. Licensed or licensed eligible in Maryland.

**Condition of Employment:** Position may require teaching in the evenings and/or weekends.
