Responsibilities: Teaches undergraduate and graduate MIS courses such as Business Information Systems, Systems Analysis and Design, Health Informatics, Data Management and Decision Support Systems, and Data Communication and Network Systems. Contributes to the department, college and university through student advising and mentoring, research, service on various committees, and outreach to community, external businesses and industry partners.

Required Qualifications: Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Information Systems or related field from an accredited institution, and some relevant teaching experience. The applicant's academic focus, research programs or professional experience should be in areas directly related to Information Systems (IS). Commitment to excellence in teaching, services, technology application in the classroom for diverse students, and effective communication skills are essential.

Preferred Qualifications: Relevant teaching experience at the university level with diverse group of students and other stake holders, and a record of peer reviewed publications and/or certifications in the field of IS are preferred. Online teaching experience and secondary interests in healthcare informatics, analytics, IT entrepreneurship and/or cybersecurity are preferred. Also work experience in business or industry relevant to teaching and research is desirable.
