Responsibilities: Teaches undergraduate courses in the content areas of Sport Management or other classes as assigned as well as engage in service-related activities within the local sport community. Teaches 12 credit hours per semester (Fall and Spring); demonstrates teaching strategies and techniques that are designed to meet the needs of diverse learners via methodology and pedagogy utilizing state of the art technology; supports the review and revision to update the curriculum for Sport Management in an effort to meet COSMA, State of Maryland, local and council standards culminating in accreditation; demonstrates knowledge of continuous current professional organizational standards for the programs; works collaboratively with colleagues, schools, community and outside organizations to ensure adherence to Sport Management requirements; demonstrates skills for the advisement of students and maintains records in Sport Management; serves on various departmental and university committees; implements assessments that measure student performance within the program and unit. This is a tenure track position.

Qualifications: Earned doctorate (Ph.D., Ed.D) in Sport Management or a closely related field preferred. Documented evidence of working with various diverse student populations and an ability to provide quality instruction at the undergraduate and/or graduate level. Documented knowledge of education procedures, policies, management, finance and relevant laws with a strong ability to conduct and publish scholarly research. Must be proficient in the use of computer technology, excellent communication skills with the ability to conduct and publish scholarly research.
