Responsibilities: Teaches four classes during fall and spring semesters, totally eight classes per academic year; recruits and advises students; serves on departmental and college committees; serves as field liaison to students in internship settings; performs other duties and responsibilities as assigned. This is a full-time, nine-month contractual (non-tenure track) position.

Qualifications: Master Degree in Social Work from a CSWE-accredited program is required. A minimum five (5) years post master's practice experience, licensure at the master's level, and a minimum of two (2) years adjunct teaching experience at the undergraduate level in social work are required. Teaching responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following areas: Introduction to social work, social work with black families, social work and ethics, and social work and health.
