<u>Commuting Not What You Expected?</u> <u>Thinking About Living in Traditional Housing?</u>

If you answered yes, here is what you need to know and do for campus accommodations. In order to be considered for on campus accommodations, you must complete the online application. Before you get started, please visit the Office of Residence Life (ORL) page on Bowie State's website and read the information about our on campus housing. **ORL does not and cannot guarantee housing accommodations for anyone.** The application will available beginning April 18, 2017. You must comply with the following requirements before submitting the online application.



Application Requirements:

- $\sqrt{\text{Enrolled in Fall 2017 classes, and}}$
- $\sqrt{}$ Financially clear with the University, and
- √ Pay the \$200.00 room non-refundable room deposit; and
- √ Have no judicial sanction(s) prohibiting applicant from residing on campus.

If you have not met all of the requirements you will not be able to access the application.

If you have met all of the above requirements, you may submit an online application.

Payments

All Payments must be made with the Office of Student Accounts. You can contact them at 301-860-3495 to pay by phone or you may send a check or money order by mail to their office. If your deposit is received on or after April 18th, you have just enrolled in Fall 2017 classes on or after that date, please wait 24 business hours to log into the application. After 24 business hours you can access the application @ http://cbord01.campus.bowiestate.edu/WebPatron/Login.asp?TargetPage=Default.asp or go to the BSU website, www.bowiestate.edu, click the Campus Life link, then the Office of Residence Life link. Please be advised ORL does not and cannot guarantee housing accommodations for anyone.

Once you have enrolled in classes, paid your deposit and filled out the application, you are done. ORL will contact you via email concerning your housing status.

Hall/Room Assignments

ORL will begin the assignment process July 7, 2107 for Spring 2017 commuter students and re-admit students. This process will continue through the second week of the semester **AS SPACE ALLOWS.** Applications for students who resided in CMRC for the Spring 2017 will not be reviewed until Mid-August, if space permits. As space allows, assignments will only be made for students who are enrolled in classes for the Fall 2017 semester and financially cleared with the University. ORL will contact you by email if you receive an assignment.

If you have any questions regarding housing, please contact ORL at the telephone number and/or email address listed in this newsletter.

Please Note: If you apply to live in CMRC and receive an assignment you must cancel your application for traditional housing. Students cannot have a lease and a contract simultaneously.
