Application Requirements For The

Non-First Time Freshman Traditional Housing Application

You must have met <u>ALL</u> of the requirements below at the time of application:

- You must have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.3.
- You must have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.7 and 60 credit hours minimum for Goodloe Apartments.
- You may not have resided in traditional housing more than 8 semesters.
- You may not have any judicial sanction which prohibits you from residing on campus.
- You must not have an outstanding balance with the University. Anyone who owes money will not be considered.
- You must be enrolled in classes' full time, minimum of 12 credit hours, for the Fall 2018 semester.*
- Pay \$200.00 non-refundable housing deposit with the Office of Student Accounts.*

*You will not be able to access the application if you do not enrolled in classes for Fall and pay the \$200 deposit.

Application Requirements For The

Non-First Time Freshman Enclave Application

You must have met <u>ALL</u> of the requirements below at the time of application:

- You must have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5.
- You must have a minimum of 24 credit and a maximum of 90 credit hours.
- You must not have an outstanding balance with the University. Anyone who owes money will not be considered.
- You must be enrolled in classes full time, minimum of 12 credit hours, for the Fall 2018 semester.*
- You must pay a \$200.00 non-refundable housing deposit with the Office of Student Accounts. *
- Never received any judicial sanctions for physical violence, drugs, alcohol, or weapons
- You must maintain Satisfactory Academic Performance (SAP) requirements.
- You must pass a criminal background check.

If you do not meet all the requirements above, you are not eligible to apply to the Enclave.

*If you have not met all of the requirements, you will not be able to access the application.

Assignment Process

ORL will begin the assignment process the week of June 11th

The assignment process will continue through the second week of the semester **AS SPACE ALLOWS**. We will send you an email to your BSU email account, if you receive an assignment.

Please be advised housing in the traditional halls is very limited. Most spaces are earmarked for first-time freshmen. Non-First time freshmen are encouraged to apply to the on campus apartments, CMRC or the Enclave.

PAYING THE DEPOSIT

The room deposit must be made with the Office of Students Accounts. You may contact the Office of Student Accounts at 301-860-3495 to pay by phone, send a check or money order by mail to their office, or pay in person. If you enroll in classes or your deposit is received on or after April 17th, 2018, you must wait 24 business hours before you can access the application @ <u>http://cbord01.campus.bowiestate.edu/WebPatron/Login.asp?TargetPage=Default.asp</u> or go to BSU's main webpage @ www.bowiestate.edu, click the <u>Campus Life</u> link, then the <u>Office of Residence Life</u> link and finally the <u>Housing Application</u> link to apply.

Applicants can complete both applications. The \$200.00 deposit is only paid once!

THE RE-CAP

Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements. The "*Non-First Time Freshmen Traditional Housing Application*" will be available starting April 17th and the "*Non-First Time Freshmen Enclave Housing Application*" will be available starting *May 1st*. Registration for Fall 2018 begins April 16th. The "*Non-First Time Freshmen Traditional Housing Application*" will close on June 15th. Remember, you must be enrolled full–time in classes (minimum of 12 credit hours) for the Fall 2018 semester and pay the \$200.00 non-refundable room deposit no later than 4:30 p.m., June 14th in order to access the application by June 15th. Applications must be filled out by 11:59 pm, June 15th. Assignments will begin the week of June 11th as space allows. *PAYING THE ROOM DEPOSIT DOES NOT GUARANTEE HOUSING. COMPLETING AN APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE HOUSING*." Emails concerning your housing status will be sent to your Bowie State email. CHECK YOUR EMAIL ACCOUNT BEFOR CALLING THE OFFICE FOR STATUS.
