## Dwight Oliver Wendell Holmes Hall

Building Type: Traditional 3 story residence hall with double rooms, limited triples, community bathrooms and showers.

Occupancy: 125 Residents

Gender: Male


Classification: Freshman

Room Dimensions: 12 FT. X 14 FT.

Dwight Holmes Hall was built in 1951 and is the second oldest residence hall on the campus of Bowie State University. Holmes Hall is now the male residence hall housing first year students.

Gender: Female

Room Dimensions: Approx. 11FT. X 16 FT.

This residence hall houses first time female students and has a limited number of single rooms for upper-class students. The First Year Freshman Experience begins in Towers Hall as the residence hall housing the largest number of freshman females.

## Harriet Tubman Hall

**Room Dimensions:** Approximately 14 FT. X 10 FT.

Harriet Tubman Hall is the oldest building on the campus of Bowie State University and opened in 1921. Named after Harriet Tubman, leader of the underground railroad and heroine to the African American race this residence hall is known for having a strong sense of community.



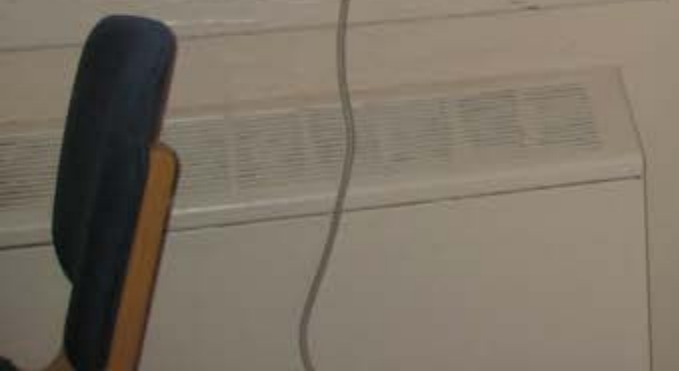

1912: became head of the Zoology Department at Howard University  
1916: received the first Spingarn Medal from NAACP  
1918: received his Ph.D.  
1929: published book, "The Biology of the Cell Surface"
