How to Read and Download EBSCO eBooks at Bowie State University

You need to:

- 1. Have valid Bulldog Card for 14 digit Library# to search and view eBbooks
- 2. Create **EBSCOhost ID** and Password to save and download eBooks
- 3. Create Adobe ID to read eBooks in Adobe Digital Edition
- 4. Download **Adobe Digital Edition** to manage downloaded eBooks https://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html

- 2. And then prepare your Adobe ID to manage your checked out eBooks in **Adobe Digital Edition**

To import your checked out eBooks from EBSCO eBooks Collection to **RefWorks**, go back (login) to EBSCO eBooks collection and click on **Folder or Checked out** on the right top corner of the window.

Select the eBook you want to save citation to open, and then click on Export icon *RefWorks <u>https://refworks.proquest.com</u> (must use BSU e-mail to create account)
